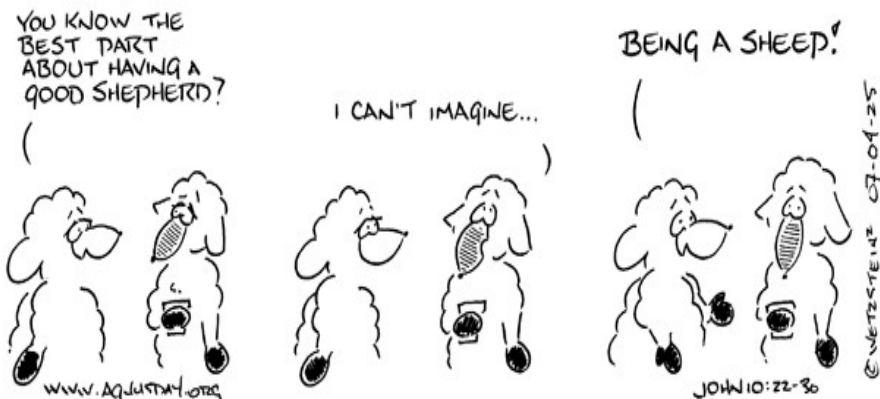

***During this season of Easter,*** a couple of things are different about the services from the rest of the year. First, the tall candle, the "Paschal Candle", burns from early in the morning, during Bible class and church and is not extinguished until most everyone is gone after church. This symbolizes the presence of the risen Christ with His disciples during that 40 day time between Easter Sunday and Christ's ascension. Also, the first lesson is from the book of Acts instead of from the Old Testament. This reading, during the rest of the church year, comes from the Old Testament and most often tells a part of the history of God's Old Testament Church. During Easter, which is the dawn of a New Testament, readings are about the history of God's New Testament Church. Acts is that history book of the Bible.
