Attention all Youth! Sunday, September 18, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. will be our kickoff of monthly Youth activities! We will have a family get together/cookout at the Fellowship Hall. Each family should bring a dish to pass and table service. Meat and drinks will be provided. We will plan the year of activities and start off with a community service project to hand out to our local farmers!! Come and join the fun!

Youth Group is open for anyone starting confirmation, in Junior High, in High School, and College age. We welcome you with open arms. Be ready to have some fun this year!

LWML Project. The LWML is asking the congregation to help with a very important project. We are collecting 2012 calendars (8 1/2 x 11) for women in prison, and fabric and thread to place into Fabric Kits for our Lutheran World Relief Collection. Sewing is a valuable skill, one that leads to a reliable income for many women and men in other countries. Fabric Kits supply vocational training programs with fabric for teaching sewing, and for newly trained tailors to launch their sewing businesses. This provides "bundles of hope." Young women in West Africa face many challenges as they enter early adulthood. Learning marketable skills to

support themselves and contribute to their families can often keep them from being married off at a young age.

Therefore, we are collecting pieces of cotton or cotton-blend fabric (no knits or 100% polyester); fabric should have no stains or holes and be cut into pieces measuring 2 1/4 yards of 60" wide fabric, 3 yards of 44" wide fabric, or 4 yards of 36" wide fabric. We are also collecting spools of matching or neutral-colored general purpose thread, 250-300 yards each. Please place these items in the box labeled "LWML Collections" on the elder's pew at the back of the church. We are only collecting till October 23, 2011. Thanks for supporting this worthwhile project!

Thank you to all the ladies who came to quilt yesterday. Through Lutheran World Relief, where our quilts are sent, families throughout the world are given a helping hand, a sign of comfort, and hope for the future. Thank you Osman ladies for using your hands to help people in need!
