

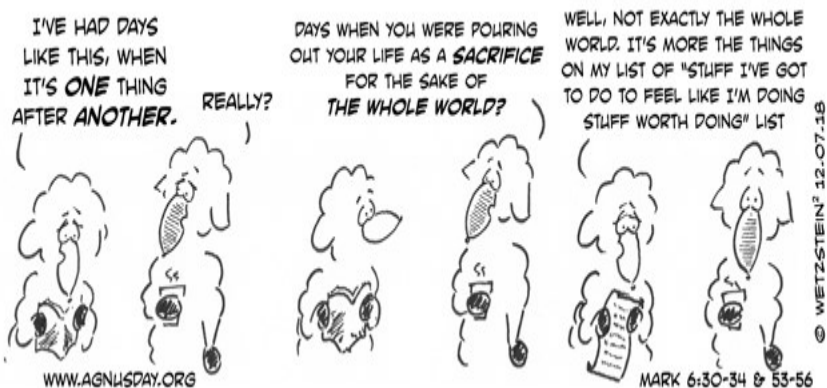

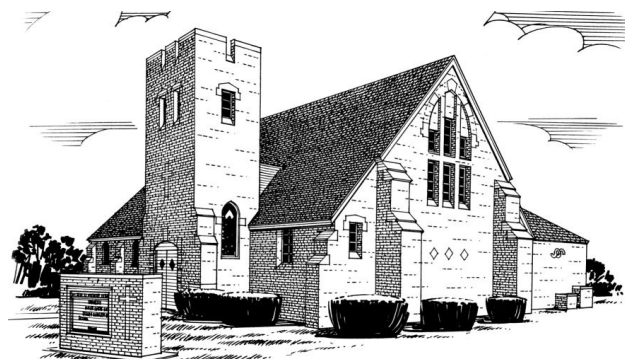

Stain Glass Crosses and Picture Frames! On the back table today are two boxes. One is labeled picture frame and the other cross. There are samples on the table, but each is different in color due to the color of glass. The frames are \$30, and the crosses are \$15. If there are items left, there will be another drawing in August. There are 25 frames and 25 crosses that were created by two men from Jacksonville Stained Glass Company in Jacksonville, Illinois.

Parts of the float are now decorating the back bulletin board under the balcony in the church. We could not do this project without the help of the congregation. There will be a collection box on the back elder's pew.
